

DEDICATION

A BIT OF HISTORY OF LIND SCHOOL

compiled from The History of Adams County Washington, Volumes I & II, Adams County Historical Museum, and past Lind High School yearbooks.

The first public school was organized in Lind in 1890. The first building consisting of a single room was completed in 1891. Due to lack of funds each child was required to bring their own desk and chair to school and furnish their own textbooks. Henry Jansen and Walker Merriman, two of the early pioneers of Lind, were instrumental in obtaining the first school for the community and were members of the first school board. The first teacher was Burt Neare who taught all 8 grades. The children who attended the first school in Lind in 1890 were: Annie Jansen, Fritz Jansen, Christina Jansen, Essie Armstrong, Tom Fitzpatrick, Mike Fitzpatrick, Clarence Lipold, Florence Lipold, William Lipold. The first school building was used both for a school and church.

In 1903, longest serving school board member (15 years), John Krehbiel was instrumental in constructing the Brick School Building in 1908 and later a new gymnasium. Other board members who served during the early history of the Lind Schools were: Walker Merriman, 1901-03; Al. R. Haas, 1903-07; T. L. Middleton, 1907-10; M. L. Schemmerhorn, 1905-11; J. W. Henderson, 1910. The first students to graduate from the Lind High School were: Allie Urquhart and William Curry in 1909. The first girl to graduate was Carolyn Moore in 1911.

The Lind High School was the product of a gradual growth from a one-room rural school to what it is now. The first schoolhouse was built in 1898, the second in 1902, a third in 1908 (which housed both grade and high school students). The building was demolished following the completion of the now present grade school building in 1962. Lind's present Junior-Senior High building was erected in 1953. A modernization of LHS was completed in 1995-96.

The first hall composite that hangs in our hallways dates back to 1912 with graduates (Pictured: Top Row, L to R: John Schutz, Wallace Buckman, Clarence Bristow, Richell Morrison. Seated: Ruth Moore, Lois Moore, Fern Kemper, Hallie Davis). The last hall composite of Lind High School graduates to be placed is the Class of 2012.

Over 100 years of students have been educated in Lind. Some interrupted their education to serve our country and fight for our freedoms, some left after graduating to make their futures elsewhere and some stayed to raise their families and have *their futures* turn into *our past fathers and mothers* of Lind.

Keeping two separate school districts, an academic cooperative with Ritzville will begin in the fall of 2012. The current high school in Ritzville will be called Lind-Ritzville High School. The new Lind-Ritzville Middle School (which will be grades 6-8) will be conducted in Lind in the current building located at N. 507 E Street.

Sports have been combined since the fall of 2003.





We dedicate our last high school yearbook to all of those who have passed through Lind High School halls.
